

## CONTRACTORS, VENDORS & PROVEDORES PRE-NOTIFICATION FORM

(Advance notification of the requirement to enter the port facility on ship's business and/or to conduct deliveries to a vessel)

Contractors, vendors and provedores are required to pre-notify Port Security prior to their arrival at the port. This will facilitate their entry to the facility and access to the ship or area to carry out work, deliver supplies, stores or equipment.

This information along with the ship's information will assist ready identification at the gate and it will ensure access into the facility will not be unduly hampered or delayed when the Port and the ship are operating at Level I security. Note that the Port Facility Security Officer (PFSO) may have additional requirements which relates to any area or vessel and that additional access controls will be introduced at Security Level II and III. These additional controls may be introduced at short notice.

This form in electronic format will be made available to Port Agents, contractors, vendors, provedores and ship's chandlers.
