

SOUTH PORT NEW ZEALAND LIMITED

BLUFF COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

1. The purpose of the Scholarship is to encourage eligible students and members of the Bluff community to undertake tertiary or university education.
2. One Scholarship shall be offered annually.
3. The Scholarship shall be selected from:
 - (a) Candidates enrolled for a full-time course of study at a university or other tertiary institution within New Zealand.
 - (b) Candidates who are making application for admission to a university or other tertiary institution within New Zealand to undertake a full-time course of study in the coming year.
 - (c) Candidates undertaking an apprenticeship.
4. First preference will be given to students studying full-time.
5. The Scholarship shall be open to candidates who have resided in the Bluff Ward for three (3) or more years.
6. The value of the Scholarship will be \$2,000 per annum and be offered for a period of two years.
7. The South Port Scholarship may be held concurrently with other outside scholarships or bursaries.
8. The successful applicant will be selected each year by a selection panel comprising three individuals from management and staff.
9. The panel may refrain from making an award if it finds no applicant of sufficient merit.
10. Confirmation of the award of the Scholarship will be made when the panel has received verification of the applicant's enrolment in the full-time course of university or other tertiary institution.
11. Applicants will be required to attend a short interview during January 2022.
12. The closing date for Applications will be Friday, 7 January 2022.
